JUDSON COLLEGE FULL TUITION SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION 2011

Criteria for applying for Judson Scholarship are:

1. Must be enrolled in a federal/state recognized tribe or if not a member of a tribe recognized by the State of Alabama, verification will be required from the state from which the tribe originates.
2. Must have a letter of acceptance from Judson.
3. Must have a 3.3 GPA and maintain a 3.3 each quarter/semester. This scholarship is renewable so long as all requirements are met and maintained.
4. Must have an ACT score of 30. (Must have verification of score).
5. Must submit three (3) letters of recommendation: One from an educator/teacher, one from Tribal Elder, and one from anyone you choose.
6. Must be a resident of Alabama.
